Born on April 29, 1960, in Kassel, Germany, Dr. Herbert Machill began his career path in 1976 with his training as an engine fitter at Deutsche Bundesbahn (German National Railways). He went on to earn a degree in mechanical engineering at the University of Kassel. In 1986, he began working at the DaimlerChrysler Kassel factory. There, he took on various leadership functions in the areas of organization and data processing, including corporate strategy planning, business process organization, IT system design/development and IT system operation.

After his last position at DaimlerChrysler as Deputy Director of Axle Production in the automotive division, Mr. Machill transferred to debis Systemhaus, today T-Systems, in 1999 as Head of the Kassel Customer Center.

From 2001 until 2004, he headed the Business Center Germany for the region Center-West at the T-Systems Computing and Desktop Services Service Line. From 2004 until 2005, he was responsible for the Deutsche Post World Net global account. Since October 2005, he has been heading the T-Systems Services Industry Line as Senior Executive Vice President with IT/TC industry responsibility for Telematic Services, Travel, Transport & Logistics as well as Retail & Professional Services.

Additionally, Mr. Machill has held the position of Chief Executive Officer at T-Systems ZEDA GmbH & Co. KG since November 2003.

Dr. Herbert Machill received his Ph.D. from the University of Dresden, where he studied from 1996 until 2001 in addition to pursuing his career. His doctoral thesis dealt with the topic of process-oriented factory planning and the reorganization of manufacturers.
